- •NCDHHS guidance only says what health measures school systems SHOULD or COULD follow.
- •NCDHHS no longer provides explicit statewide requirements





- •Vaccines are currently available for students 12 and up
- •3% of ages 12-17 (243 children) received at least one dose of the vaccine as of August 2, 2021
- •Benchmark: 70-90% of school age population vaccinated to revisit face covering requirement

Delta Variant Transmission

• Delta variant is *more* transmissible than:

MERS & SARS

Ebola

Common Cold

Seasonal Flu

Smallpox

• Delta variant is as transmissible as:

Chicken Pox

Professional Insights Continued

Extra-Curricular Activities (Middle and High School)

- COVID transmission is higher for extracurricular activities than classroom activities
- 50-75% of school transmission in high school is during athletics
- NC required masking during athletics in 2020-21
- Some states required twice weekly testing in 2020-21

ABC Suggestions:

- All students mask at all times indoors
- All students in extra-curricular activities mask at all times outdoors unless vaccinated
- Unvaccinated participants in extra-curricular activities required to have weekly COVID tests if proof of vaccination is not provided
- Testing will be facilitated during school and results are confidential

04 Recommendation

Face Covering Required for everyone PK-12 (staff and students)

- Most protective
- Minimizes quarantines (missed school days)
- Aligns with two top priorities
 - Keep schools open for all daily in-person students
 - Keep students and staff healthy by minimizing exposures and quarantines

Ongoing Vigilance

- Continue consultations with Warren County Health Department and ABC Science Collaborative
- Monitoring metrics regularly to assess face covering guidance requirement
