

Read to Achieve (RTA)--Splash Into Reading

Who: 2nd-3rd grade students, by invitation only for those students not demonstrating reading proficiency

Where: Mariam Boyd Elementary School

What: 72 hours of reading content to yield positive reading outcomes for those 2nd-3rd grade students who meet the eligibility criteria

Instructional Focus: Daily literacy intervention for those students who do not demonstrate reading proficiency and demonstrate difficulty with reading development.

Dates: June 16-July 3, 2025

High School Credit Recovery

Who: 9th-12th grade students at WCHS and WECHS who have fallen behind in credits or have previously been unsuccessful in mastering content or skills required to receive course credit.

Where: Warren County High School

What: Courses are delivered online, via Edmentum–Courseware.
