Inclement Weather Remote Learning Plan

WCS Remote Learning Plan

North Carolina law allows public school districts to use Remote Instruction when schools are unable to open due to inclement weather. Warren County Schools can use up to five *Inclement Weather Remote Instruction Days* in lieu of in-person instruction. We believe the benefits of this approach will:

- ✓ Support continuity of instruction and learning for students
- ✓ Reduce the number of "make-up" days
- ✓ Increase the likelihood of maintaining Spring Break and ending the year as planned

The Superintendent and District Operations team will make a decision for each inclement weather occurrence on a case by case basis to determine if a remote instruction day is appropriate.

WCS Pre-K Information



Teachers will...

- Create offline assignments (packets) for inclement weather remote instruction and share with students and families.
- ✓ Communicate daily from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm via phone, Google Meet, Class Dojo, TSGold Family Engagement, and Ready Rosie-Family.
- Encourage families to ask questions and share evidence of learning at home. (i.e., pictures of activities, video logs).



Students will...

- Submit completed assignment packets to the teacher within 5 days of returning from the remote learning day(s).
- Complete work to count as attendance.
- Contact the teacher if help is needed by email, phone, or Google Meet and Class Dojo.

WCS K-8 Information



Teachers will...

- Create Google Classroom assignments for inclement weather remote instruction.
- Ensure packets or downloaded material are available for students without internet access.
- ✓ Offer help sessions from 9:00 am to 10:00 am and 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm via Google Meet or phone sessions from 10:00 am to 11:00 am and 2:00 pm to 3:30 pm.



Students will...

- Submit completed assignments in Google Classroom or to teachers within 5 days of returning from the remote learning day(s).
- Complete work to count as attendance.
- ✓ Contact the teacher if help is needed by email, phone, or Google Classroom.
