

3-Year Graduate Legislation-NC HB 259

- Law: Required by NC House Bill 259.
- **Early Graduation**: Ninth graders must be informed of the 3-year graduation option.
- Credits: 22 credits needed to qualify.
- Application: Students must apply to graduate early.

Who can be a 3-year graduate?

- Enrollment: Must attend a traditional high school.
- Age Requirement: Must be 16 by the third year.
- Credits: On track to earn 22 credits.
- Approval: Must be approved for the 3-year graduation option.

Application Process

- Submission: Parents/guardians submit the completed form to the school counselor.
- Review: Counselor checks if the student meets requirements.
- Approval Meeting: Administration, counselor, student, and parents meet to finalize.
- Eligibility: Student must stay on track for 22 credits to remain eligible.

Key Points

- Notification: Parents/guardians will be informed if the student is no longer eligible.
- Rigorous Schedule: Approved students may have a demanding course load.
- Senior Activities: Not permitted, but students can participate in graduation.
